Kathryn Fantasia serves as Executive Director, Defense Logistics Agency Energy, a field activity of the DLA at Fort Belvoir, Va., responsible for providing the Department of Defense and other government agencies with comprehensive energy solutions in the most effective and efficient manner possible.

Prior to her current position, Fantasia was the director of the Direct Delivery Fuels business unit for DLA Energy from April 2007 to January 2013. In this assignment, Fantasia was responsible for managing acquisition programs that support military and federal civilian agency ground fuel requirements around the world, exceeding \$2 billion in annual sales. In addition, Fantasia also provided oversight and management of acquisition programs in support of U.S. and coalition forces in Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Prior to that assignment, Fantasia served as DLA Energy's Direct Delivery Fuels deputy director from June 2006 to April 2007. From 2000 through 2006, she served as a division chief and contracting officer in the Direct Delivery Fuels Commodity business unit. In this capacity, Fantasia engaged in acquisition support for posts, camps and stations; commercial aviation and marine bunker fuel in support of military customers around the world. She was actively engaged in supporting contingency fuel requirements to support OEF and awarding primary support contracts in support of OEF requirements. Additionally, from November 2008 through July 2009, Fantasia served as the contracting director of the Bulk Petroleum business unit.

Fantasia began her career at DLA Energy in 1991, re-entering the workforce after a nine-year hiatus. She is certified in Contracting at Level III as of April 2000 under the Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act and is a member of the Defense Acquisition Corps since October 2001.
